The Bunche Library and Media Center (LMC) has print, multimedia, and archival materials relevant to African Americans and the diaspora, their institutions and achievements worldwide, with a particular emphasis on UCLA, Los Angeles, and the Southwestern United States. In December and January, the LMC highlights our vertical files. Vertical files create a primary source collection highly tailored to a community, subject, or time period. Usually, vertical files consist of newspaper clippings, pamphlets, flyers, photographs, and very small archival collections. The LMC currently seeks archival material (letters/newspapers/photographs, etc.) pertaining to the establishment of the Center for African American Studies at UCLA (CAAS), alumni success stories, and projects of note.
