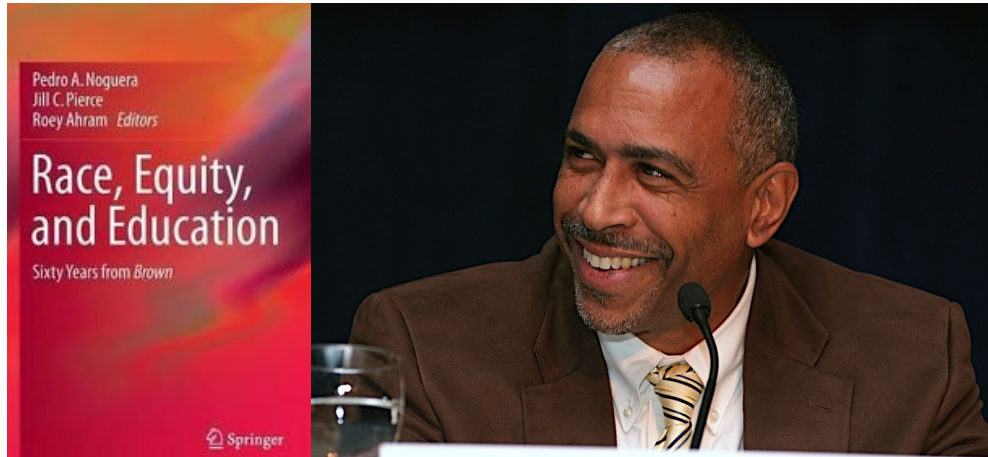

Pedro Noguera, Distinguished Professor of Education at UCLA, will discuss his new book, *Race, Equity and Education: Sixty Years from Brown*.
